PUBLIC TRANSPORT

How to get to the conference venue

Public transportation in Warsaw is well-developed and convenient. The information regarding timetables and route is clearly specified on the stops (timetable and routes) and within the vehicles (route). Busses 193, 401, 166 and 148 have bus stops along the SGGW-WULS campus. The 148 bus also allows access to the Chopin airport. The SGGW-WULS campus is located in the 1st city zone. Warsaw is split into two zones, most likely you will need only a ticket for the 1st zone. If you are planning to venture to the suburbs please check on the map below if you will need a 2nd zone ticket:

The conference venue (Water Center) is located next to the "Ciszewskiego" bus stop. Note that it is an on demand stop so you need to press the button on the bus to indicate you are getting off or if you are waiting on the bus stop you will need to wave at the bus driver. The Gala dinner and the Inaugural session will take place on the side of the campus close to the "SGGW-Rektorat" bus stop.

The conference venue can be reached from the city center by metro (M1 towards Kabaty) and afterwards bus (401 or 193 from bus stop "Metro Służew 01" just outside the Służew Metro Station) with the approximate journey time of 30 minutes (from Metro Centrum). The other option is to take the metro M1 towards Kabaty and get off at Metro Stokłosy and walk to the venue (from Metro Centrum: approx. 15min. on the metro and a 15 min. walk).

How to buy a ticket

Each public transportation ticket (ZTM) allows you to travel on all ZTM Warszawa means of transport in the City: buses, trams, metro, suburban SKM trains. Eg. With a single 75min. ticket you can travel on the metro, tram, bus and suburban SKM trains.

In vehicles of ZTM lines only tickets issued by ZTM Warszawa are acceptable. Such tickets may be bought in the sale network, including among others, Passenger Service Centres, post offices, authorised points of sale (kiosks) and ticket vending machines (located at the metro station entrances and on-board of most buses). Single fare tickets, time-limit tickets and short-term tickets are sold on a carrier in a form of a paper card with a magnetic strip. There is a validating machine to be found by the door on all buses, trams, and urban rapid rail (in the metro they are located at the entrances to the stations). Tickets which have not been validated earlier, i.e. each single fare ticket or unused seasonal or time-limit ticket, should be validated immediately after boarding the vehicle.

Eg. One-day ticket (Dobowy) entitles to unlimited number of journeys for 24 hours from its validation and costs 15 PLN (standard fare, 1st zone), a three-day (3-dniowy) ticket costs 36 PLN (standard fare, 1st zone).

UBER

An Uber from Warsaw City Center to SGGW-WULS costs around 30 PLN (11 km which takes 14-28 min. – depending if it's the rush hour).

TAXI

When using taxis in Warsaw, it is strongly recommended that you only use taxis with the following: beacon sign "TAXI", a hologram with the license number and the vehicle's registration number on the front glass and on yellow/red stripes with the symbol of Warsaw – a mermaid affixed along both front doors. Inside the vehicle in a visible place there should be a special id card with a hologram, drivers picture (with his or hers name) and a taximeter showing the tariff and the current charge. Detailed information about the price per kilometer and the complaint procedure must be displayed on the glass of the right-hand side back door (in the upper left corner). Driver is obliged to give passenger a receipt, stating also the side number of the taxi and the vehicle's registration number.

A Taxi from Warsaw City Center to SGGW-WULS costs around 30 PLN (11 km which takes 14-28 min. – depending if it's the rush hour).

Current prices (maximum rates legally permitted):

Initial/starting fee - 8 PLN

Day fare, in the urban zone - 3 PLN per km

Night fare, in the urban zone, and day fare on Sundays and holidays - 4.50 PLN per km Day fare, in suburban areas - 6 PLN per km

Night fare, in suburban areas, and day fare on Sundays and holidays - 9 PLN per km 1 hour in which the driver waits for the passenger - 40 PLN
